The purpose of the Federal Women's Program Interagency Council (FWPIC) is to provide a forum where Federal Women's Program Managers in the Washington, DC Metropolitan Area can exchange Federal Women's Program management information concerning activities, training, report preparation, workplace and diversity issues, lessons learned, and successes related to the Federal Women's Program.

Sue served as the keynote speaker for this monthly meeting, but she asked me to come along and discuss the FEW FWP Resolution. I briefed the group on the purpose of the resolution and specific actions that are to be addressed by the taskforce. The following are recommendations from the FWPIC;

- Develop a section on FEW's website for the resolution to include what actions are being taken, updates, and request that FEW members provide information about FWPM's within their respective agencies.
- Obtain a list of EEO Directors from the Council of Federal EEO and Civil Rights Executives and use this list to communicate directly with EEO Directors and ask that they provide the taskforce with information from their MD-715 report.
- Contact the Council of Federal EEO and Civil Rights Executives and ask that we be placed on their commission meeting agenda to discuss the resolution.
- Expand our efforts and research why more women aren't in scientific, technology, engineering and mathematics occupations.
